## AUSSIECON 4 ANNOUNCES AT-THE-DOOR MEMBERSHIP RATES

Aussiecon 4, the 2010 World Science Fiction Convention, to be held in Melbourne, has set its at-the-door membership rates.

The membership rates are currently:

- o Attending membership: AU \$310
- o Supporting membership: AU \$70
- o Child (age 6 to 16 years at 2 September 2010): AU \$50
- o Supporting membership conversion to full attending membership: AU \$250

These rates remain in effect through August 15.

Beginning August 16, and extending through the conference, the rates will be:

- o Attending membership for the entire conference: AU \$375
- o Attending membership for one day: AU \$95
- o Supporting membership: AU \$70
- o Child (age 6 to 16 years at 2 September 2010): AU \$50
- o Supporting membership conversion to full attending membership: AU \$305

Aussiecon 4 is the 68th Worldcon and the fourth located in Australia. The convention will be held 2-6 September 2010 at the Melbourne Convention and Exhibition Centre. Guests of Honour for Aussiecon 4 are award-winning author Kim Stanley Robinson, award-winning Melbourne artist Shaun Tan, and dedicated fan Robin Johnson.
